Eligibility

- Three primary criteria:
 - Master's level Schulich students
 - Candidates must plan to register in courses in the Fall 2021 semester
 - Candidates must be able to hold office from the beginning of May 2021 until the end of April 2022
- Candidates for President and Vice President & Academic Affairs must plan to register in courses through the Winter 2022 semester
- Students need not be registered in Summer courses to run in the election
- One-year master's students that are studying through the end of the Fall 2021 term are eligible to run for any of the 8 Director positions

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Executive Roles: President

- Oversees the activities of the GBC Executive and of all Council members
- Ensures the sustainability of the Graduate Business Council
- Establishes projects aimed to enrich the student experience and to continue to adapt the Council to meet students' needs
- Acts as liaison between the Faculty/Administration and the Council
- Liaises with Schulich's Launch Week Organizing Committee



Executive Roles: Vice President & Academic Affairs

- Acts as Academic Liaison between students and the faculty: specifically, working closely with the Associate Dean Academic
- Identifies academic issues of students and communicates these to faculty, so as to support students and attempt to resolve issues
- Works to manage and better the internal processes and day to day operations of the GBC
- Selects the Chief Returning Officer (CRO) to oversee GBC elections

- Sits on the SIRC (York U Intramural Committee)

- Promotes skill development and participation in case competitions hosted internally
- Organizes the four rounds of Dean's Cup

- Organizes the Culture Crawl
- Acts as the liaison between the GBC and the Open Arms Committee

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Nomination

Nomination period: February 22 – February 26

Nomination process:

- Submit the online nomination form
 - A link to the nomination form will be sent via email on the morning of February 22
- Within the nomination form, you'll submit 4 pieces:
 - 1 campaign video (60 seconds maximum)
 - 1 campaign write-up (300 words maximum)
 - 1 headshot
 - 1 completed signature form (available on the Election Hub webpage)
- Attend one mandatory all-candidates meeting (February 26 at 12:00 pm EST or 6:00 pm EST)



Campaigning

Campaign period: March 1 – March 9

Campaign details:

- Optional Open Forum on March 5, 2:00 pm EST
- Videos and written platforms submitted through the nomination form will be hosted on the GBC website
- Additional campaigning is strongly encouraged
 - Learn from your colleagues about the issues that matter to them
 - Share your platforms
 - Be creative



Rules

The full Rules and Regulations document is available on the Election Hub webpage. All nominees will agree to abide by rules and regulations with the submission of their nomination forms.

Select Rules and Regulations:

- Candidates will send the CRO links to all websites and social media accounts established for the purposes of campaigning
- Campaigning can only take place within the campaign period (March 1 March 9) no campaigning is allowed during the blackout period
- Candidates are limited to one post every 24 hours in Schulich WhatsApp threads, other social media platforms, and on OneSchulich
- Short in-class pitches are allowed, but only with instructor permission
- Spamming students via class lists, Canvas, or listservs is strictly prohibited



Next Steps

- 1. Download the signature form from the Election Hub webpage, and gather 10 signatures in support of your candidacy
- 2. Submit the online nomination form between February 22 and 26, along with your video, write-up, headshot, and completed signature form
- 3. Attend an all-candidates meeting on February 26
- 4. Campaign between March 1 and 9
- 5. Participate in the Open Forum on March 5
- 6. Vote between March 11 and 12
- 7. Attend the result announcement event on March 13
