Thank you for registering to be a team captain and supporting St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. We won't stop until no child dies from cancer and we can't do it without you!

Now that you've taken the first step in helping to cure childhood cancer, here are some other quick ways to get your fundraising started:



Recruit Your Team Members

- Encourage family, friends and coworkers to join your team.
- Recruit 10-15 other team members to join you. **The average team** size is 11 members.
- Team members can choose to participate **in-person** or **virtually** (from anywhere they are).



Set Your Team and Personal Goals

- Log in to your personal Fundraising Center.
- Customize your team page and personal fundrasing. Share your team's reason for participating!
- Team Captains who personalize their team page and recruit additional team members raise, on average, 30% more than fundraisers with default page content.



Start Your Fundraising by Making a Personal Donation

- Did you know that the average St. Jude Walk/Run participant raises \$321?
- **Inspire your donors to give** by showing your investment in the cause and asking them to join you.



Share Your Progress With Your Team

- Share your team's progress on social media! Highlight your team members' success!
- Download team stats from the St. Jude Walk/Run mobile App.

Connect Your Team Goals to Gifts That Make a Difference!

St. Jude has the freedom to focus on what matters most—saving kids regardless of their financial situation. Every dollar makes a difference. We encourage you to set your team goal and inspire your team members and donors to make it happen!

\$25,000

Helps provide fifteen days of intravenous chemotherapy for a leukemia or solid tumor patient

\$18,500

Helps provide one day of inpatient care for two patients

\$15,000

Helps cover the cost of two and a half CT scans for St. Jude patients

\$10,000

Helps provide grocery gift cards for two years for one St. Jude family

\$8,000

Helps provide two St. Jude patients with proton therapy

\$4,000

Helps cover the cost of the daily room rate of the ICU

\$2,500

Helps cover the cost of 13 days of oxygen for a St. Jude patient \$1,000

Helps cover about two-thirds of the cost of one day of chemotherapy.

Fundraising Tools

Personalize Your Page

- Once you are in your dashboard, in your fundraising section, you can customize your personal and team fundraising links.
- Participants who personalize their page raise, on average, 30% more than fundraisers with default page content.



Launch Facebook Fundraising

- Combine your personal fundraising page with Facebook fundraisers!
 This tool is a great way to share your fundraising progress and encourage donors in a seamless and user friendly way.
- To get started, personalize your fundraising page and set up your Facebook fundraiser through through the fundraising center or through the St. Jude Walk/Run mobile app.
- Participants who utilize Facebook Fundrasing raise 3-4 gifts or \$164 more on average than participants who do not.



Download St. Jude Walk/Run mobile App

- Send messages via text, LinkedIn, WhatsApp, email, Twitter, Facebook and Snapchat to ask your friends, family and colleagues for support.
- Schedule social posts to Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn with updated fundraising totals and your donation link.
- Edit your personal fundraising page content to share your story of why you Walk/Run for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.
- Participants can deposit checks using the mobile check deposit feature. This eliminates the need to mail these in or wait on the delay for the donation to adjust your fundraising totals.

St. Jude Story

He was a desperate man, who did what desperate men often do.

He made a promise – a promise to the patron saint of hopeless causes, St. Jude Thaddeus.


"Show me my way in life," said Danny Thomas, a struggling entertainer with a young family to support, "and someday I will build you a shrine."

St. Jude Children's Research Hospital is one man's promise that's become an unprecedented beacon of hope and healing for the world. It's a place not just of life-saving treatment and ground-breaking research, but a haven for kids to be kids, finding a sense of normalcy amid the tumult of disease. It's a place filled with art that uplifts and inspires, from the 1.2 million shimmering sequins that make up a courtyard art installation to the patients' own creations in the ABCs of Cancer display.

Consider how it must have sounded, at the time: A hospital to cure childhood diseases thought to be incurable, built in the early 1960s segregated South and meant to treat all children, regardless of color or creed or a family's socio-economic station.

Audacious as it sounds, it happened, thanks to self-described "proud beggar" Danny Thomas, who became an entertainment legend – but did his best work as a humanitarian who never forgot his promise.

And it's happening still. The single, star-shaped building that opened on Feb. 4, 1962, has given way to a 66-acre campus where research and treatments have helped push the overall childhood cancer survival rate from 20 percent when the hospital opened to more than 80 percent today. And we won't stop until no child dies from cancer.

At St. Jude, one thing has always been certain: with your support, we won't stop until no child dies from cancer. Together, nothing is impossible.




