Subject: Orientation Housing Options





We are so excited for your arrival in August to begin your journey at Gies College of Business with our MSBA orientation! As a reminder, the MSBA orientation is a 2-week onboarding experience where you and your new classmates will get to attend professional development workshops, career training, business fundamentals along with teambuilding activities and social events. While the first week of orientation (starting August 8) is optional, we strongly encourage you to attend as there will be many sessions you won't want to miss, such as the MSBA alumni panel and registration info session. The 2nd week of orientation (beginning the morning of August 15) is mandatory, and it is expected that MSBA students attend. Stay tuned for more information about orientation activities in the coming weeks as we know that many of you are already making your travel and housing plans.

Since many of the on-campus housing options in Champaign-Urbana (whether a private apartment or University Housing) don't offer move-in dates until closer to the first day of classes, we want to let you know about an affordable option available to you for a portion of the MSBA orientation timeframe. See details below:

Pre-Arrival Interim Housing Option via University Housing:

- Cost: \$40 per night/per person
 - Charged directly to your student account, where tuition and fees are billed.
- Dates available: Any date range between August 1, 2022 and August 14, 2022.
 - Latest available checkout is on Sunday morning, August 14, at 8:00am.
- Location: Illinois Street Residence Hall (ISR)
- Room type: Double occupancy dorm room (2 separate beds in 1 room)
 - Single (individual) rooms are not available.
 - Rooms include pillow, mattress, blanket, towels, washcloths and linens laid on bed. For stays longer than 7 days, weekly linen exchange. Towels are exchanged at the front desk.
- Roommate matching process will be determined via the University Housing and MSBA program staff and the information provided on the registration form.
- If you have a Fall contract with University Housing, you can check into your Fall residence hall on Sunday, August 14, after checking out of the interim-housing arrangement. For more information on this arrangement, please click here.

 All utilities, high speed internet, standard cable channels, water, trash, and on-site parking are included in the rental fee. All vehicles must be registered at check-in.
 Most units do not have air-conditioning.
 - Minimum one month stay.

Important Considerations

- Network and meet your classmates now! Even if you can only talk or meet virtually, pairing up can
 make the cost significantly cheaper if you are willing to stay with someone else. Join the MSBA
 WhatsApp group to network and find roommates!
- If you have already signed a lease to live in an apartment, check to see if you can arrange to move in early with your landlord. Ask questions, sometimes landlords might be more flexible if you offer to pay an early move in fee.
- Check Craigslist or Facebook Marketplace or other online websites for students that are subleasing their apartment for the summer. Many of them may be willing to make a short-term deal with you to use their space.

- Check into the CU Mass Transit District (MTD)—this is the bus system available to all students free
