Tuition for the Hybrid MBA Class of 2025 is \$135,000. The program consists of a minimum of 54 credit hours. Students who take a minimum load of 9 credit hours per semester are considered full-time. This document details the standard curriculum for the program, but pursued credits will vary by semester. The Jones Graduate School of Business does not charge students on a per credit basis. The Rice University Cashier's Office bills students \$33,750 each semester for tuition regardless of the number of credits being pursued.
