Guidelines for completing the electronic NY BOLE Certificate of Attendance Form

Credits awarded toward the degree: 24 or more

Attendance:

- a. Month and year you commenced LL.M. degree program: August 2023
- b. Month and year you completed all coursework for LL.M. Degree: May 2024
- c. Date of Graduation: **05/15/2024**
- **e.** Did you complete your LL.M. degree within 24 months of matriculation: You should answer **"YES"** in this section.

Coursework:

- a. List the **title and number of points** of the course you took to satisfy the **Professional Responsibility** requirement.
- b. List *LL.M. Legal Research and Writing* 2 points if you took this course.
- c. American Legal Studies, Legal System: List *Introduction to American Law* 2 points if you took this course.
- d. & e. List the courses you took in the <u>subjects tested on the NY Bar Exam</u>, and in other substantive law courses. Check with your academic advisor in the Office of Graduate Degree Programs (OGP), if you need assistance in completing these sections.

<u>Did you complete any courses as part of joint degree program:</u> You should answer "NO" in this section.

<u>Summer Credits:</u> You should answer "NO" in this section.

Location and Distance Learning:

- a. Did you attend all courses, including clinics, externships and field placements, within the borders of the United States? You should answer <u>"YES"</u> in this section.
