2. Registration Holds

Before Pre-Registration begins, ensure that you do not have any holds on your student account as these can prevent you from participating in Pre-Registration.





• 1L Elective

Select "1L Elective" under the Registration Services menu.



This process mirrors the Legal Methods II Elective ranking procedure.

5. Requesting Changes to Legal Methods II and 1L Electives

Although there is no formal provision (such as Add/Drop) to change your Legal Methods II and 1L Electives classes, there may be opportunities to switch, depending on seat availability. Please note that no changes can be made to your pre-assigned cohort classes.

- The Legal Methods II switch request period is from Tuesday, November 22 at 12:00 p.m. EST Tuesday, November 29 at 12:00 p.m. EST
- If you wish to request a change to your Legal Methods II registration, please complete and submit the Legal Methods II Switch Request form.
- 1L Elective switch request period is from Tuesday, January 17 at 12:00 p.m. EST -Thursday, January 19 at 12:00 p.m. EST
- If you wish to request a change to your 1L Elective registration, please complete and submit the <u>1L Elective Switch Request form</u>.

No change is guaranteed but all changes, if made, are final.
