ADA TESTING ACCOMMODATIONS

NY (UBE)

Filing Deadline: April 30

Encouraged to file as early as 6 months prior to exam administration (February)

NYLE

Filing Deadline:

90 days prior to exam date

MPRE

Must apply <u>prior</u> to registering for exam.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

- Registration Services is authorized to forward an official copy of your Columbia University transcript to the various state bar organizations.
- You do not need to make a separate request.
