# **University Transfer Policies**

#### **Credit Equivalency**

• Students always earn the number of credits they took the course for at the other institution regardless of what BW offers the course for.

#### Associate Degrees/Two Year Colleges

- At most, a student can transfer in 60 credits from a two-year institution
- Students with an associate degree are guaranteed 60 credits. Blanket hours should be awarded if there are not 60 credits of transferrable work.
- If a student has taken more than 60 credits, they can work with their advisor and Registration & Records to select the most useful equivalencies for transfer.

# Four-Year Colleges

• There is no limit on the number of credits that can be transferred in from a 4-year university.

#### **Core Waivers**

- Students transferring with an Associate degree are awarded the simplified A2BW core
- Students transferring without an Associate degree but with at least students with 25 transfer credits are awarded the OT36 Core. This does not apply to first-time first-semester freshman.

#### **Review Statuses**

- Some courses require faculty review before being assigned an equivalency.
  - Courses assigned ELECT-REVIEW (elective review) are guaranteed to transfer in for credit. The relevant department must review a course description and/or syllabus for a specific equivalency.
  - Courses assigned DEPT-REVIEW (department review) must be reviewed by the relevant department before transferring in at all. No credit is guaranteed until the course description and/or syllabus is reviewed.

#### **Experiential Learning**

- EXP must be completed at BW
- Some transfer courses may cover the same classroom content as a BW EXP class. Those
  classes are given equivalencies without the X designation that will still fulfill some other
  requirements.

# First Year Experiences/Seminars/Etc.

- 1 credit success/orientation courses do not transfer
- Seminar style courses of 2+ credits can come in as GEN-ELE or ELECT-REVIEW.

#### **Grade Requirements**

- Students must receive a C or better in a class to transfer it to BW.
- If a student has a pass/fail grade, we can only bring in passing grades for which a C and above (not a C-) are included.

# **Tech Prep Credit**

• BW does not accept courses offered as tech prep.

# Subjects with Limited Credit at BW

- The following non-departmental credit types are capped at certain numbers of semester hours:
  - Interior Design (INTD) 6
  - o Journalism (JMC) 6 as HUM GEN
  - Manufacturing Technology (MIT) 3
  - Office Administration (OADM) 4
  - o Real Estate (REAL) 10
- The following prefixes are not accepted for credit from Tri-C
  - o AUTO
  - o C&CR
  - o EMT
  - o ESL
  - GEN
  - o HIM
  - o HOSP
  - NURS
  - o PL
  - o RADT
  - o DMS
  - o SDEV
  - o INSUR

# **Varsity Sports**

• No varsity sports transfer (as BW varsity sports do not count for credit)

# **Independent Work**

- Independent studies, practicums, and field experiences do not transfer
- Credit for courses taken as part of a student abroad experience can only be given if the transcript from the school abroad is submitted for review.

#### **Duplicate Work**

- BW only gives credit for an equivalency a single time.
- If a student has taken courses at two schools, and courses at both have the same equivalency, only one of the courses will transfer.
- If a student took a course at another school and took a test (AP, CLEP, etc.) that result in the same equivalency, only the transfer course will be awarded credit.
- Students transferring with an Associate degree will not be granted blanket hours if they have used credit from another institution to fulfill their requirements.
